The **Saskatchewan Animal Enforcement Agency (SAEA)** keeps owned animals safe across Saskatchewan!

Animal Protection Officers (APOs) are **dedicated protectors** for animals — like Child Protective Services, but for animals!

⚠ SAEA helps owned animals only.
Not strays, wildlife, or City of Regina cases.

The Law That Protects Animals 📄

The Animal Protection Act, 2018

Saskatchewan law requires every owner to care for their animals:

- Kindness and respect
- Food, water, and shelter
- Vet care when sick
- Protection from cruelty

If an animal isn't cared for,
APOs can **investigate and help!**

Different Jobs, Same Goal! 🐕

Animal Control Officers (ACO)

- Helps stray and lost animals
- Responds to barking complaints
- Handles animals running loose
- Works for a city or town

Animal Protection Officers (APO)

- Investigates neglect and cruelty
- Ensures owned animals are cared for
- Enforces *The Animal Protection Act, 2018*
- Works throughout Saskatchewan
- Does not handle strays or wildlife

Be Kind & Gentle

Treat animals with care. Never tease or hurt them.



Always Ask First

Ask before petting someone else's pet.



Tell a Trusted Adult

If an animal needs help, tell a grown-up right away.



Stay Safe

Never enter someone's property alone.
Let adults handle it!
